Who, Where, and When

Junior camp is for all young people who are between 3rd and 6th grade. Camp will be held at Fernwood Christian Camp, in Chippewa, PA. Registration form and camp fee (and preferably snack shop money(\$15)) must be sent to Bible Baptist Temple, 230 Lettie Ave. Campbell OH 44405, and must be postmarked by July 1st . Any campers not registered by this time will need to call to make sure a spot is open, and a \$20 late fee will apply. Camp will begin at 11:00 AM August 1st and end at 1:00 PM on August 5th. The cost for camp will be \$80. Picture CDs will be available; every camper on the winning team will receive a free Picture CD. These also may be purchased at the end of the week out of whatever snack shop money is left, they will be \$ 5.00.
