## Who, Where, and When

**Teen camp** is for all young people who are between 7<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Camp will be held at Fernwood Christian Camp, in Chippewa, PA. Registration form and camp fee (and preferably snack shop money (\$15)) must be sent to Bible Baptist Temple, 230 Lettie Ave. Campbell OH 44405, and must be postmarked by June 1<sup>st</sup>. Any campers not registered by this time will need to call to make sure a spot is open, and a \$20 late fee will apply. Camp will begin at 11:00am July 11<sup>th</sup> and end at 11:00 am on July 16<sup>th</sup>. The cost for camp will be \$ 100. Picture CDs will be available; every camper on the winning team will receive a free Picture CD. These also may be purchased at the end of the week out of whatever snack shop money is left, they will be \$ 5.00.

## What NOT to Bring

Items that hinder the spirit of camp will not be permitted on the camp. Radios, CD/Tape/MP3 players/recorders, cell phones, pagers, computers, video games, magazines or books of any kind, tobacco products, drugs, alcohol, firecrackers, knives, guns, illegal substances, or potentially dangerous items. Bad attitudes will not be tolerated. We reserve the right to disapprove of any attitudes, actions or appearances that are not in agreement with the spirit of our camp. No camper should have medicine, or money on them or in their luggage it should be turned into church leader before leaving for camp It also should be properly labeled, preferably in a zip-lock bag.

## Dress Code

**Everyone** must be covered from shoulders to knees and everything in-between.  
**Boys** – Loose fitting pants need to be worn all week. No tank tops, sleeveless/sideless shirts, mesh shirts, shorts or clothing with inappropriate symbols or advertisements. Long shorts and a dark T-Shirt are to be worn during swim time. No feminine type jewelry allowed. Don't forget to bring dressier clothes for chapel (Shirts with collars are preferred).  
**Girls** – Modest loose fitting shirts (covering the whole shoulder), loose fitting Modest skirts (no slits above the knee) and skirt appearing culottes are to be worn all week. Other clothing that has a skirt like appearance (although not encouraged) can be considered with senior staff approval. Long shorts and a dark T-Shirt are to be worn during swim time. No tank tops, sleeveless tops, or clothing with inappropriate symbols or advertisements. Don't forget dressier clothes for chapel.
