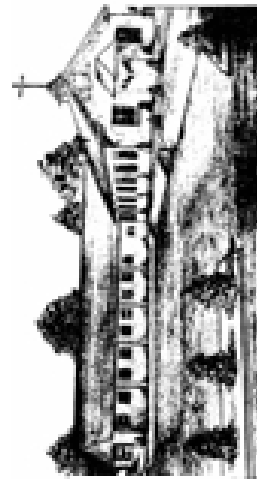

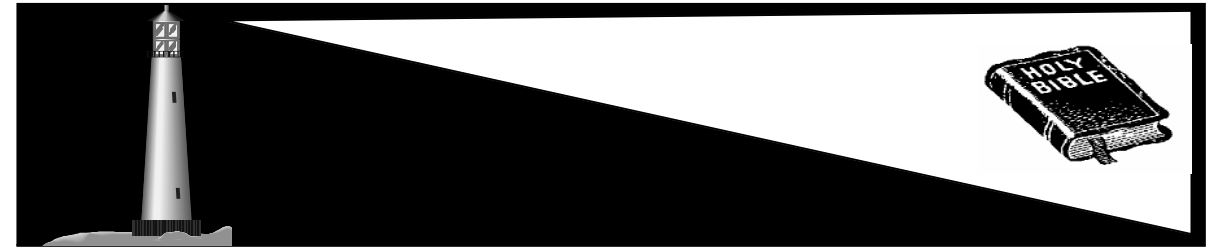

Sunday Morning – Going Down

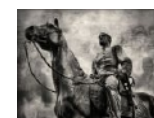
In Judges 14:1-7, Samson went down 3 times. From chapter 13, we see that there was such potential and value placed in the life of Samson, but he went down from the path that was planned for him.

Sunday Evening – Wrong Places

In Judges 14:4-6, Samson neglects his Nazarite Vow. He killed a lion in a vineyard, which was not against his vow, but he should have never been in the vineyard. How many times do we put ourselves in the wrong place?

Monday Evening – Turning Aside

In Judges 14:7-9, Samson was retuning to marry the woman from Timnath and he retuned to the vineyard. Not only was he attracted to the place that he should not have been in, but he took the honey out of the dead lion. The lion was unclean because it did not have hooves. The honey was unclean because it was from a dead animal. Samson had desecrated his Nazarite Vow. Not only did he sin, but he caused his parents to sin with him. How many times does sin cause those we love to participate in our grief?



Tuesday Evening – Mockery of Sin

In Judges 14:10-14, Samson made light of his sin. He uses his sin as a riddle to stump his companion. When has sin lost its sting in our society? There used to be a place where a person could go and know that people would stand for right, no matter what. That place used to be the church and the pulpit, but many people will not allow the church to do its job.

Wednesday Evening – Company of Sinners

In Judges 14:12-20, Samson has placed himself and those around him in a desperate place. His riddle and the wager he had made put everyone in a mood of desperation. His companions, not friends, threatened his wife and her family. Samson had to kill 30 men to fulfill his end of the bargain. What part of life will the Devil not exploit to destroy the life of a Christian?
